Role Information



Purpose of the Role

The Bike Fleet Maintenance Volunteer helps keep our bike fleet safe, reliable and ready for weekly cycling sessions. This role requires practical experience in bike mechanics to ensure bikes are serviced to a high standard, supporting safe, enjoyable cycling for children, young people and community groups.

What You'll Be Doing

- Cleaning bikes after a week of use, including frames, wheels, chains, handlebars and seats.
- Completing detailed safety checks on brakes, tyres, gears, wheels, drivetrains and overall bike condition.
- Carrying out intermediate repairs such as replacing brake and gear cables, adjusting derailleurs, replacing brake pads, tightening or replacing worn components, and minor wheel truing.
- Identifying and reporting any issues requiring advanced repair or staff oversight.
- Keeping the bike workshop and storage areas tidy, organised and safe.
- Using tools, cleaning products and PPE safely and appropriately.
- Following the Charity's health & safety and safeguarding procedures.
- Working independently or alongside staff/volunteers to ensure the fleet is ready for the following week.

- Confident in bicycle maintenance and intermediate repairs
- Able to replace brake and gear cables and adjust gears and brakes
- Skilled at identifying worn or unsafe bike components
- Practical, reliable, and comfortable working independently
- Strong attention to detail with a focus on safety
- Friendly, positive, and supportive of the Charity's values

You will be helping care for a farm that provides life-enhancing experiences for children who need them most — while spending time outdoors, learning new skills and being part of something positive and grounded in community.



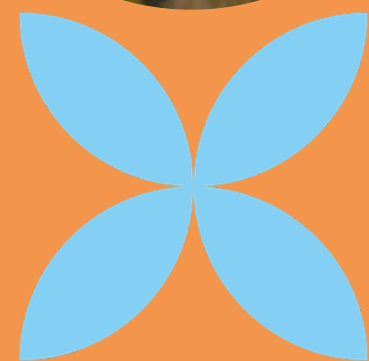
Putting Children First
